





### IN FOCUS

Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (CED), Anna University has been instrumental in working towards creating a robust Innovation & Entrepreneurship (I & E) Ecosystem at Anna University & affiliated Colleges, thereby extending to all Higher Education Institutions across all streams in Tamil Nadu from Nov 2024.

CED is progressive in conducting STARTIFY series of hackathons to bring together all stakeholders in the Startup Ecosystem, including Academicians, Investors, Researchers, Students, Entrepreneurship Development Cells, Student Startups, and aspiring entrepreneurs with the goal of fostering Entrepreneurship. These events specifically designed for academic stakeholders of Tamil Nadu are aligned with Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)/National Missions to stimulate sustainable innovation, leading to viable prototypes and open the gates of Stupreneurship. CED also provides effective mentoring and MAKERS LAB support for prototyping assistance to the innovations through CED Preincubation (CEDi).

### Evolution....

#### Project - Prototype - StartUp

Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (CED), Anna University was established in 2003 with the objective of motivating students towards converting the innovative ideas into potential StartUps. The Centre has been creating awareness on Design Thinking and Innovation related specialised training programs and workshops involving the StartUp community in Tamilnadu. Inspired by the quantum and level of awareness and focused training programs on various activities related to entrepreneurship carried out by CED, the students of Anna University were very successful in establishing their own ventures after graduation.

This is very much evident from the present-day Unicorns and Top industries which has founders, cofounders and CEOs from our Alumni fraternity.

CED AU received this recognition on 16 July 2025 from the Hon'ble Minister of MSME, TN Thiru. T. M. Anbarasan - a 5 year partnership from EDII-TN for implementing TNYIEDP (TamilNadu Youth Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Programme) in all Higher Education Institutions of Chennai District.


To nurture the StartUp culture across the State, CED collaborated with EDII, TN from 2016 using a Hub & Spoke model approach by creating an E - Cell (Entrepreneurship Cell) in every College as Nodal Hub and associating it with the neighbouring Colleges as Spoke Colleges. This approach included Colleges from Engineering, Polytechnic, Medicine, Arts & Management. The approach was very successful with CED furthering to create CAPITALIZE club (now renamed as Anna University Student Entrepreneurship Club - AUSEC) to conduct annual state-level Innovation / StartUp Fest for students, ENANTRA, funded by EDII-TN, attracting more student footfalls / participations year-on-year.





#### **EcoSystem Partnerships - Innovation Support System**

Startify was conducted as a structured, multi-phase entrepreneurship development program by the Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (CED), Anna University, with support from StartupTN. The program was designed to nurture innovation and startup thinking among students across Tamil Nadu's higher educational institutions.



Started with institutional outreach, registrations, orientation sessions, design thinking, idea validation.

Shortlisted teams participated in bootcamps and mentoring workshops, where industry experts and startup mentors guided them on business model development, market research, and prototype creation.

Participants presented their ideas through regional pitch rounds, leading to state-level evaluations. Top-performing teams received mentoring support for incubation and scaling. Throughout the program, Startify emphasized experiential learning, teamwork, & problem-solving, creating a strong pipeline of youth innovators and potential entrepreneurs across the state.

































The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also known as Global Goals, are a set of 17 integrated and interrelated goals to end poverty, protect the planet and ensure that humanity enjoys peace and prosperity by 2030. The SDGs are anticipated to generate at least US\$12 trillion worth of market opportunities by 2030, which makes a strong business case for investing in opportunities aligned with the SDGs for investors and businesses.

Startup Café, PitchX, Scholar Spin-Off, Faculty Pitch, Instaventure and IP-to-IPO are the annual prototyping hackathons, organized by CED under STARTIFY and are tailored to students of Higher Education Institutions across all disciplines in Tamil Nadu, aimed at fostering sustainable innovation aligned with SDG Goals and National Missions. The event focuses on addressing problems related to these goals, sourced from industry and government stakeholders. It spans multiple stages to engage students from all regions of Tamil Nadu. CED provides mentoring and support to innovative projects through CED Pre-incubation. The outcomes include Technology Transfer for industry readiness, innovation patenting, and the incorporation of viable startups.

Through these initiatives our goal is to align with global sustainability efforts, and periodically mapping the identified innovations in-line with National Missions thereby communicating our sustainable efforts clearly with the rest of the world.







- Policy and Ecosystem Alignment: Directly supported StartupTN's objectives and Tamil Nadu's Startup & Innovation Policy, reinforcing a culture of youth entrepreneurship.

### The Impact

Startify has created a transformative impact on Tamil Nadu's student innovation and entrepreneurship landscape. The program **instilled** an entrepreneurial mindset among thousands of young learners, shifting their perspective from job-seeking to problem-solving and value creation.

By integrating design thinking, innovation, and startup literacy into the academic environment, Startify strengthened the culture of ideation and experimentation across higher education institutions. It also bridged the gap between academia, industry, and government, enabling stronger collaboration through mentorship, funding linkages, and exposure opportunities. Overall, Startify has positioned Tamil Nadu as a national leader in

### The Outcome

Startify successfully created vibrant for student innovation and ecosystem entrepreneurship across Tamil Nadu. The program reached over 550+ institutions and 25,000+ students. fostering creativity, problem-solving, and startup readiness among youth.

Through multi-phase interventions—idea generation, design thinking bootcamps, and pitching rounds—over 1600+ innovative of which 300+ ideas were curated. prototypes and MVPs were shortlisted. 250+ teams progressed to incubation or preincubation stages under CED and partner incubators. The participation from women students and rural colleges significantly increased innovation inclusivity.

Startify also contributed to policy-level impact, aligning with Tamil Nadu's Startup and Innovation Mission goals. The program culminated in the Tamil Nadu Global Startup Summit (TNGSS), where student entrepreneurs showcased their innovations, marking Startify as a model framework for large-scale student entrepreneurship development.




